Grant Committee Update

The Grant Committee had busy months in March and April with over 30 applications to review! Each member of the Committee carefully reviewed and scored each application, and the scores were compiled and averaged. We met as a group in April to review the grant score sheets and to discuss each application and score further, and the Committee made recommendations on what they would like presented to the Board for approval.

On April 27th, these recommendations were presented to the Board, and the Board members approved all 13 recommendations. On May 11th, the 2023 General Membership and Grant Vote was held at Harford Community College, and we are incredibly proud to say the membership approved of the 13 grantees, totaling \$54,724! To date, the WGC has granted 162 grants, totaling a sum of \$564,924.14!

We are in the process of notifying all of the non-profits that applied for funding, and an announcement of the 2023 grantees will be made soon!
