## A Message from the Chair



The 2022 Grant Cycle has begun, and it is off to a great start! We have already received several inquiries from local nonprofits.

The grant guidelines and applications were posted (WGC Homepage, Facebook, emails, Wild Apricot, etc.) on January 14, 2022. A pre-application meeting for prospective applicants will be held on **January 24, 2022, at 3 PM via Zoom**. Registration for the pre-application meeting is open on the events page of our website. Take a look at the WGC site and share the information with your friends and colleagues in the non-profit community. Encourage them to apply for a grant – up to \$5,000 could be waiting for their organization!

To be considered for funding, applicants must submit their application, required documents, and budget by **March 11th** at **noon** – not a minute later!! So, get started now.

If you want to be a part of the action, please consider joining the Grant Committee by becoming a grant reviewer, participating in the committee review, and making recommendations for 2022 grant funding. Our first Grant Committee meeting of the year will be on **February 4, 2022, at 8 AM via Zoom**. No prior experience is necessary!
